FIRST SEMESTER MISSIONS –

It is one of two schools that are part of the Native Christians Ministry. East Fork Lutheran School has been sharing God's Word with the Apache people for over 100 years! They serve approximately 180 students and in spring of 2019 graduated their first senior class since the high school portion of the school restarted in 2015. This school is just one of several programs Native Christians has to give hope to children and strengthen their faith as they learn of Jesus' love.
